Situated between the Breede River and Langeberg mountains in Robertson, lies Bon Courage Wine Estate. Here, the Bruwer family, produce a selection of fine wines, ranging from noble whites, classic reds and fortified dessert wines to the elegant and award winning Cap Classique sparkling wines.

**Inkará** - Since its inception in 2001 this premium range has consistently proven to produce excellent "terroir" driven wines, only hand-picked grapes from specific vineyards are used. The Inkara range is the brainchild of winemaker, Jacques, and the name is derived from the names of his three children, Inge, Karli and Andre and pays tribute to the 4<sup>th</sup> generation of Bruwer's. The range is an outstanding addition to any discerning wine connoisseur's collection.



Cultivar: Cabernet Sauvignon

Wine Style: Full-bodied Red Wine

Winemaking: The grapes were whole berry fermented and cold soaked. 3/4

through primary fermentation, half of the wine was racked into 100% new French oak barrels. The rest was left to ferment dry on the skins. It was then racked into 100% new French oak barrels after 6 months. The wine was then oak matured for

18—24 months in 100% new oak.

Winemakers: Jacques Bruwer & Philip Viljoen

Aroma: Rich, spicy and smoky with hints of mint.

Palate: Complex, expressing soft, round tannins and subtle ripe black

fruit.

Ageing Potential: Made to be enjoyed now or within 5 years.

Serve with: Served with a wide range of meat dishes. The ideal partner—

lamb, roasted turkey, steak or meaty casserole dishes. Any dish infused with rosemary and thyme as well as dishes with a

dark chocolate-chili sauce.
