Situated between the Breede River and Langeberg mountains in Robertson, lies Bon Courage Wine Estate. Here, the Bruwer family, produce a selection of fine wines, ranging from noble whites, classic reds and fortified dessert wines to the elegant and award winning Cap Classique sparkling wines.

**Inkará** - Since its inception in 2001 this premium range has consistently proven to produce excellent "terroir" driven wines, only hand-picked grapes from specific vineyards are used. The Inkara range is the brainchild of winemaker, Jacques, and the name is derived from the names of his three children, Inge, Karli and Andre and pays tribute to the 4<sup>th</sup> generation of Bruwer's. The range is an outstanding addition to any discerning wine connoisseur's collection.



Cultivar: Pinot Noir

Wine Style: Full-bodied Red Wine

Winemaking: After early morning harvesting, the whole berries were cold

soaked for 24 hours in the cellar, and had 72 hours skin contact. The juice was fermented dry in rotor tanks. The wine matured for 18 - 24 months in 2nd fill and 3rd fill French oak

barrels.

Winemakers: Jacques Bruwer & Philip Viljoen

Aroma: Delicate hints of vanilla, strawberry fruit, spicy and earthy

tones.

Palate: Earthiness follows through onto the palate with a lingering

finish.

Ageing Potential: Made to be enjoyed now or within 5 years.

Serve with: The perfect match for chicken cooked in any style, especially

fruity sauces as well as game or light meat dishes served in a

classic red wine sauce or basted with barbeque sauce.
